REACH

The chemical regulation of European Union.

REACH standards for the Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH). It entered into force on 1 June 2007



To whom it may concern,

We hereby declare that any detected product, which is not in conformity to the REACH SVHC candidate list, will be systematically cancelled and replaced by an authorised substitute. We declare that our products are compliant to all entries added to the Candidate List on 17 January 2023.

B6 Nordic A/S and B6 A/S continuously monitors that our used materials do not contain any substances mentioned in the candidate list. The B6 Group is in regular contact with our raw material suppliers and we can confirm that all products used in our activities comply with the current REACH regulation.

About REACH?

REACH, which stands for Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemical Substances, is the name of a European Commission Regulation (EC No. 1907/2006) ensures that more than 100,000 different types of chemicals used in the EU, has been documented in terms of human and environmental safety. The proposal has implications for all chemicals produced, imported or applied to a quantity of min. 1 tonne per year of a company in an EU Member State. For a number of the most hazardous chemicals (harmful to health and the environment) companies are obliged to use a less hazardous chemical if possible.

The role of the supplier in relation to REACH:

REACH split up the companies into four categories. The role depends on where you are placed in the supply chain.

- Importer
- Producer
- Downstream User
- Distributor
